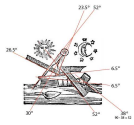

Benevolent Fund Scholarship has been increased
to a value of up to \$10,000 per year for four years
for those attending a college or university in
Colorado. There is also a one-time \$3000
scholarship for a student attending a Vo-Tech
school or pursuing a two year Associates Degree
at a community college. Additionally, there are
two Educational Grants that are awarded by the
lodge that carry a total value of \$500, with \$250
coming from the Lodge and a matching \$250 from
the Grand Lodge. Finally, there is \$300 available
from the Lodge for a Masonic Band Camp
scholarship.

March and April are going to be very busy months
for us with the degree work and the Grand
Master's visit. Please manage your 24 inch gauge
appropriately and support the fraternity.
